IDEAS FOR BUSY FAMILIES

ON THE MOVE

In this unit, your child is learning about TRANSPORTATION.

-Talk with your child about how people need transportation. Explain different kinds of transportation, such as trains, cars, trucks, buses, and airplanes.

-If possible, take your child on a bus or train, or in a car. Or, show your child pictures of people in different types of vehicles. Talk about the advantages of transportation, pointing out that vehicles allow people to go farther faster.

AT BATH AND BED TIME

In this unit, your child is learning about boats.

-While your child is in the bathtub, talk about boats. If possible, show how a toy boat floats. Explain to your child that boats are vehicles that travel on the water. This discussion will help your child to develop his or her vocabulary.

-To help your child visualize how a boat floats, place an empty plastic bottle, with the cap on, in a sink or bathtub filled with water. Then push the bottle.
