- Opportunity to advance grade levels at any time of the year
- **Full-time behavior technician-this staff member is available to take a walk with a student, be with them if they need time outside the classroom, and teach “Zones of Regulation” and “Habits of Success” for social/emotional regulation**
- Non-traditional furniture and seating options
- **Students may bring sealed snacks and drinks for use during the day**
- Each student is assigned a mentor teacher who will be the same mentor for their entire time at MJH
- **Student input on mastery content**
- Community service
- **No homework**
- We offer our own summer school program
- **Opportunity to be a preschool aide**
